News

Fremantle SLSC did very well at *State Champion Patrol Competition* on Sunday 21st February. We entered two teams, one in the Open division and one in the U17 category.

Our Open team, comprising Kieran Nettleton (Patrol Captain), Brett Jensen, Jean Michel Lagesse, Ben Pink, Chris Pink and Paul Prisley did very well – after forming the team only two weeks ago, and with 4 quick training sessions under their belts took out the Bronze medal – and only 8 points behind Silver.

The Under 17 team were returning for the second year to the competition with the addition of Lauren Lankester to the team of Lex Kuster (Patrol Captain), Sam Bilton, Dani Lankester and Lauren. The Under 17's did exceptionally well, going one better than the result from last year, and achieved State Gold Medals – 24 points clear of their closest opposition. The Under 17's have now won the right to contest the National Title at Kurrawa on the 16th March.

Additionally, two weeks ago at the State Champion Lifesaver Competition, Lex won State Gold in the U17 male division, Dani won State Gold in the U17 female division, Perri Rose Jackson won State Silver in the U15 female division and Chris K won Bronze in the Open male division (competing against 3 guys in their 20's!) Minor placings were taken by Sam Bilton, Lauren Lankester and Olivia Morris.

Last weekend the State First Aid Competition was held at Floreat with Fremantle represented in the U15 division (two teams), the U17 division (one team) and the U19 division (one team) with Alex Colquhoun and Lex K taking out State Bronze in the U19 division.

Fremantle SLSC will be well represented at Aussies with Lex and Dani going straight to National Finals for U17 Champion Lifesaver, Lex, Dani, Sam and Lauren going straight to National Finals for U17 Champion Patrol, not to mention other possibilities as they compete through the heats for the 2km beach run, board rescue, surf race, and boat races through our male and female boatie teams.

Please congratulate our champion Patrol teams the next time you see them at the Club – they all wore the Freo cap very proudly on the beach.
